100" span, 1700 sq inches of wing area, all up flying weight of about 17 lbs.

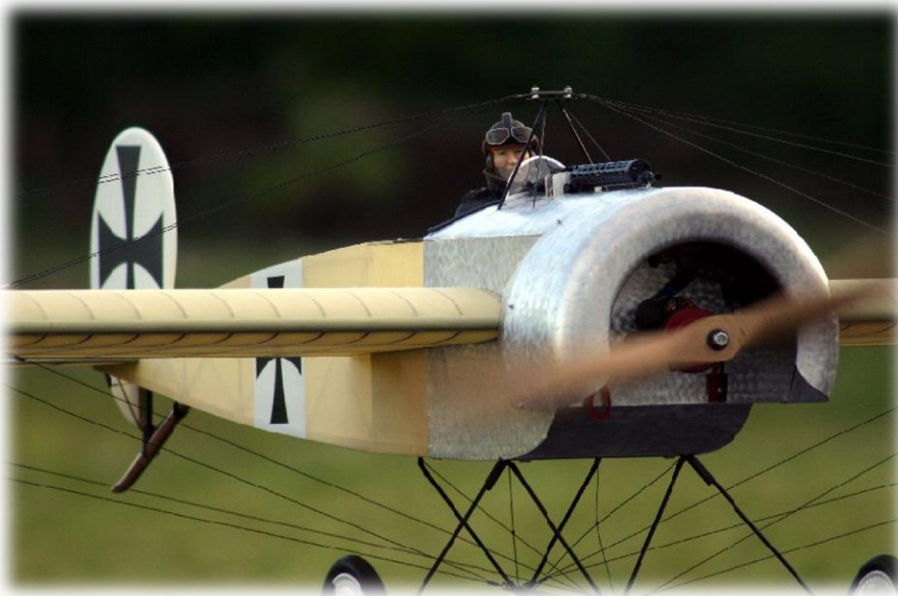
Built in 2005, with approximately 30 flights on the plane. Stock airframe with extensively modified exterior for a more scale appearance.



Has won numerous trophies in both static and flying competitions. Dummy Gnome rotary engine, Spandau gun, Aces of Iron pilot, cockpit detailing, etc. Flying wires and hardware replaced with Proctor items.



Covered in Solartex with custom made graphics. Powered by a Mega 22-45-2 in an Inner Demon 48 gearbox with a 6.6:1 ratio, turning a 24 x 10 Top Flight Power Point wood prop. The Eindecker will fly for 20-30 minutes on a charge depending on flying style, and is particularly impressive on slow fly-by's and "touch n go's".



Uses a 10S2P 2450 battery pack in the current configuration.



Been on display indoors for the last 4 years. Needs ESC installed to be airworthy. \$1200 with wingbags, plans, and any spares I might have. Photos do not show dummy radial installed.
