

## Mixes Are Really Simple by Andy Kunz

*I have only used the pre-built mixes in my DX9 (and only a couple of them) and they don't feel like mixes. I have visited the Mixes screen and quickly left for fear I may change something that I cannot fix.*

That's not going to happen. All you would need to do is change the Switch to INH and the mix will be like you never did anything.

Mixes are really simple. You take a portion of one input (the left item at the top, the "XXX" of XXX > YYY). The size of the portion depends on the Rate values below. That portion is added to the YYY output.

That will get you started.

Eventually, I would like to get to the point where I could read Freechip's sequencer blog and understand it enough to program my DX9's Betty to growl when I have the throttle above 5% and throttle cut set. This has bit me a couple times on small planes slamming into something when I release throttle cut... it's only a matter of time, as my planes get larger.

The best cure for that is CONSISTENT SAFE PRACTICES.
