General information

General Discussion—Randy Ling reported that the current membership stands at 39 with 32 open members, with 5 youth, and 2 non-flying members.

Expenses since last meeting are \$75.00, for renew of the permit with the city of Seattle for continued limited use of the float fly location. Continuing expenses are field lawn care supplies, and porta potty service.

New Business

Randy reviewed the proposed calendar of cub meetings and events for 2023 calendar. Of note will be the annual gate lock combination change late in March. Randy reminded all that cars are to remain on the gravel roadways at all times when driving and parking at the field. A new set of traffic cones have been placed in the car park area to clearly indicate the limit of car parking.
