7:35-----General Discussion---More gravel has been delivered to the field---honorary member-ships were given to; Lyle and Charlian Jorgenson (former members donated a riding lawn Mower) and Dean Bulker (solid waste operations manager donated field improvement materials)---club jackets are available for about \$90.00---club hats are also available---a motion to pay \$56.00 for the permit to fly float planes on Lake Washington was approved---240 persons signed the float plane log

8:00-----Show and Tell---Ken Murdock brought three electric powered models---Thomas Richards brought an electric powered Osprey V-22
