7:00-----Meeting called to order by Marlow Anderson (president)---there were 28 persons present---all members introduced themselves (three new members were welcomed into the club)---the minutes for the December meeting were read by Robert Burks (secretary)---the minutes were accepted and approved as read---a financial report was given by Steve Green (treasurer)---the Cedar Grange building has been secured as our meeting place for the next year

7:10-----Show and Tell---Thomas Richards brought an electric powered foam jet, a hand airplane launcher and information on an electric powered airplane car---Dennis Sivak brought a F86 electric foam jet (wing span 47 inches)---Gerry Drake brought an electric trainer purchased from Hobby King

7:30-----Guest Speaker---Bill Wilson a retired F111A (Aardvark) pilot and presently a docent at The Museum of Flight shared a personal history of his 33 missions over North Vietnam which included details about his capture (also the navigator) and their imprisonment in the Hanoi Hilton---December 22, 1972 engine on fire (the cock pit is ejected)---December 27, failed rescue attempt by Super Jolly Green---December 29, captured and imprisoned---his navigator had also been captured at a different location and imprisoned---their imprisonment lasted 90 days and they were among the last to be evacuated when the armistice was approved---the presentation was accompanied with audio and visual information which occurred during and after the conflict
