Mixing to Use DX6 Elevator to Control Camera by Andy Kunz

I have a Dx6, can you use the elevator channel to control a servo for a camera when just hovering? I added a servo to my quad to control the tilt of my FPV camera. I have an open channel, AUX1. I want to flip a switch D, to use the elevator channel to position the tilt of the fpv camera. Then flip the switch again to regain control of the elevator channel to continue to fly. Have any of you guys done this with your DX6 and an open channel? If not have any of you used a 3 position switch to control servo movement?

Yes you can do that. You use the mixes.

One mix would turn off the elevator (mix ELE > ELE at -100%) in one switch position.

Another mix would move the elevator to AUX1 (mix ELE > AX1 (at appropriate %) when the switch is in that same position.

This is really basic mixing.
