That's why you want to read the PDF that comes with the download (get the 2 PDFs right under the orange download button). We describe in a very limited form what is available in each update.

When we make a new radio that has the feature, then the manual for it covers it, so you end up reading the DX18G2 manual to get more info on DX9 features, and the DX7 manual to get updates to the DX18, DX9, and DX6 radios.

Maybe some day we'll have a Master Manual that covers all the features.

Editor's Notes: The two PDF files for the DX9 are:

1. Software Update Read Me file (Spektrum Airware Change Log 1.09)

Note: For the DX9, New Features and Improvements are in Change Log 1.08. Change Log 1.09 is about the fixes to make Airware version 1.09 work. You only need to download and install the latest version of Airware.

2. How to (Installation instructions)

You should see similar files on the download page for your Tx, but I can only see the download page for my DX9. This is because each Airware download is coded with your transmitter serial number to prevent you from installing the wrong software.

3. Also, download the Spektrum Speaking Transmitter Audio files.

The Spektrum Audio Editor can be found <u>here</u>. (Used for all Speaking Transmitters)

You can only download the Change Log for transmitters you own, but you can download any of the transmitter manuals.
